The discussion included what the anticipated economic impact the Brewery will have in Vernon. The EDAC will arrange and participate in a ribbon cutting ceremony at the opening of the Brewery, Brewery is expected to open in May this year
- A discussion to develop and host a townwide Forum on Economic Development that will include the participation/ presentation of several sponsors including a local bank, local real estate firm, USDA Representative and possibly a developer. The date is to be determined but will be no later than September 2024
- Committee discussed the possibility of leading an initiative to generate funding of a Township Clock to be erected on a yet to be determined location
