## **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

Complete the attached form and either mail it to: Vernon Police Department 21 Church Street Vernon, NJ 07462 or drop it off at the Vernon Police Department.

You can expect your permits to be sent back to you via US Postal Service within approximately 5 business days.

It is highly recommended that you apply for your permits as soon as possible as permits may not be available on short notice if you wait until you need them.

There are two types of parking permits available:

- 1) Hanging permits (3.25" x 7.75")
  - a. These can be used on any vehicle to park on the roadway in the area of the residence to which it was issued.
  - b. These permits shall be displayed by hanging them from the vehicles rear view mirror when needed.
  - c. Each residence may receive up to 5 of these permits.
  - d. These would typically be used for vehicles belonging to guests but may also be used for any vehicles owned by the resident.
  - e. These permits are not transferable and must be surrendered to the Vernon Police Department if the person to whom they were issued no longer resides at the address.
  - f. It is the responsibility of the resident to whom the permit was issued to immediately report if any permit becomes missing at any time.
- 2) Resident vehicles parking decals (2" x 3")
  - a. These can only be used by vehicles registered to an address located within the Appalachian Trail Permit Parking Area. If you require a permit for a company or business vehicle please list it on the form and include a copy of the vehicles registration with the application.
  - b. These decals may not be used on guest's vehicles or other vehicles owned by the resident but are not registered to the address listed within the Appalachian Trail Permit Parking Area.
  - c. These permits shall be applied to the left rear window of the vehicle.
  - d. It is the responsibility of the resident to whom the permit was issued to remove the parking decal prior to the vehicle being sold or otherwise disposed of.

In all cases it is required that all vehicles follow all New Jersey motor vehicle parking regulations when parking on any roadway, including those located within the Appalachian Trail Permit Parking Area. Including but not limited to the following examples:

- All vehicles must park on the proper side of the roadway
- No vehicle may park within 25 feet of any intersection
- No vehicle may park within 50 feet of any stop sign
