I used to pay about \$100 a quarter for garbage and recycling pickup at the end of my driveway before I dropped the service altogether. If I'm doing the work, I should be paying half price or less. The garbage people have one pickup for tons of trash, that should reflect a huge savings, not a minimal one. As someone who generated one to two at most 13-gallon bags of waste a week, that's an excessive price. A per-bag price might be reasonable like they have at scuma, but \$350 annually for drop-off service is out of the question. And hours there are so off, closed too many days, I would likely drive there and not be able to drop stuff off like has happened many times with recycling. Try again with a dirt cheap per-bag price or an annual cost of \$100 to make it worth it.





RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF VERNON, IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX, NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE FORBEARANCE OF THE RIGHT OF REDEMPTION OF CERTAIN MUNICIPALLY HELD DELINQUENT TAX LIENS ON PROPERTIES WITHIN THE MCAFFEE VILLAGE REDEVELOPMENT AREA AND DETERMINING CERTAIN RELATED MATTERS THERETO

WHEREAS, the Township of Vernon (the “**Township**”) is a political subdivision of the State of New Jersey, located in the County of Sussex; and

WHEREAS, the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, *N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et seq.*, as amended and supplemented (the “**Redevelopment Law**”), provides a process for municipalities to participate in the redevelopment and improvement of an “area in need of redevelopment”; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the criteria set forth in the Redevelopment Law, the Township identified and designated various property within the McAfee Village commercial resort area, including the properties then-identified as Block 231.01, Lot 1, commonly known as the Legends Resort, as set forth on the official tax maps of the Township as an “area in need of redevelopment” (together, the “**Redevelopment Area**”) and adopted a redevelopment plan for the Redevelopment Area entitled, “McAfee Village Commercial Resort Redevelopment Plan” (as the same may be amended and supplemented from time to time, the “**Redevelopment Plan**”); and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined to act as the “redevelopment entity” for the Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of *N.J.S.A. 54:5-1 et seq.* (the “**Tax Sale Law**”), the Township holds multiple tax liens on properties within the Redevelopment Area pursuant to one or more tax lien sales at which there were no purchasers for such liens (collectively, the “**Delinquent Liens**”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Tax Sale Law, the Township has the right to, among other things, foreclose the right of redemption with respect to such Delinquent Liens as early as six months following the applicable tax sale at which such Delinquent Liens were acquired by the Township (in each case, the “**Municipal Right of Redemption**”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Tax Sale Law, prior to any such foreclosure, the property owner(s) of the properties subject to such Delinquent Liens or their mortgagees may redeem such Delinquent Liens at any time; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the redevelopment of the Redevelopment Area pursuant to the Redevelopment Plan, on or about October 30, 2025, the property owner of a portion of the

properties subject to such Delinquent Liens, or their agent (the “**Redeeming Entity**”), paid to the Township \$275,542.21 to redeem certain of the Delinquent Liens; and

WHEREAS, such Redeeming Entity has represented that during the hereinafter defined Forbearance Period, and thereafter, the Redeeming Entity will continue to make periodic payments to the Township to continue to redeem certain of the Delinquent Liens until the Township has been paid in full for all outstanding Delinquent Liens; and

WHEREAS, based on such representations by the Redeeming Entity and in furtherance of the redevelopment of the Redevelopment Area pursuant to the Redevelopment Plan, the Township will agree to forebear from exercising its Municipal Right of Redemption with respect to the outstanding Delinquent Liens from the date hereof until March 1, 2026 (the “**Forbearance Period**”); and

WHEREAS, during such Forbearance Period, all interest, future taxes, charges and penalties shall continue to accrue to such outstanding Delinquent Liens in accordance with applicable law, including the Tax Sale Law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Vernon, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

Section 2. The Township hereby agrees to forebear from exercising its Municipal Right of Redemption with respect to the outstanding Delinquent Liens during the Forbearance Period. During such Forbearance Period, all interest, future taxes, charges and penalties shall continue to accrue to such outstanding Delinquent Liens in accordance with applicable law, including the Tax Sale Law. The Mayor of the Township is hereby authorized and directed to enter into any agreement, certificate, document or instrument necessary to effectuate the transaction contemplated by this resolution, upon review by and consent of counsel to the Township. The Township Clerk is hereby authorized to attest to the Mayor’s signature on any such agreement, certificate, document or instrument. The Mayor is hereby further authorized to take any action reasonably necessary to effectuate the transaction contemplated by this resolution.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

SECTION 4.

This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
