The VTMUA is currently seeking approval from the NJDEP for expansion of service areas with the anticipated intent of extending its sewers to increase users, meet flow capacity, decrease developer contributions, and stabilize rates. With the large influx of residents in the past 2 years to the Township, the MUA eagerly anticipates business expansion in the Town Center, along the Route 94 corridor, which could positively impact the MUA's user base.
